## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Pay the required booth fees.
2. Vendors are required to open by 11:00 a.m. on their registered days, and will remain open until 5:30 p.m.
3. All business or other activity for which the vendor has rented space must be conducted in your designated area only. No distribution or solicitations by strolling through the event is allowed without prior written agreement.
4. Prices must be posted in a legible manner, and in a visible place.
5. Vendors must dispose of food waste. Vendors may not utilize standard event trash containers.
6. Event Sponsors reserves the right to prohibit the sale or display of any items that may be illegal, obscene or pornographic as deemed by the Event Sponsors.
7. **No bottled water may distributed for free.**
8. Loud music in the Vendor Area is prohibited.
9. The Event Sponsors are not responsible for any lost or stolen items, or for any equipment rented by the vendor.
10. All applicable permits must be displayed at vendor's booth.
11. This agreement is the final writing and supersedes any prior negotiations.
12. Event Sponsors have planned what we hope to be a wonderful event again this year. We hope it will prove to be a fun and profitable experience for you. However we cannot guarantee your sales or profits.
13. You will receive a confirmation notifying you that the Event Sponsors has received your vendor application. If you do not receive a confirmation notice within 3 weeks of submitting your application please contact the Vendor Chairman at 989-453-2144.
14. All cooking or electrical appliances must conform to the Uniform Fire Code of Michigan.
15. Food vendors requiring water supply must indicate this on the Food Vendor Application Form.
16. No refunds, no exceptions. Fees paid may not be applied to a future event.
17. Acceptance of applications will be considered based upon receipt at the Event Sponsor's mailing address. While an application deadline date has not been stated, space may sell out quickly. Receipt of an application does not guarantee space is available. The Event Sponsors reserves the right to place the vendor or relocate vendor according to a master plan. Therefore, any cancellations by applicant based upon dissatisfaction of booth placement will subject applicant to forfeiture of all booth fees, in accordance with the provisions of the above cancellation policy. Submission of application and payment does not guarantee a vendor space or location.
23. Event Sponsors reserves the right to refuse vendor space at its own discretion.
24. Any violation of these rules may be grounds for immediately revoking this permit to occupy. The Event Sponsors reserves the right to retain booth fees.
25. The Applicant agree(s) to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Pigeon Chamber of Commerce, Village of Pigeon as well as it's officers and trustees or any other municipality, corporation or entity should the event location change, from any claim, demand, suit, loss, cost or expense, or any damage which may be asserted, claimed or recovered against or from the Pigeon Chamber of Commerce, Village of Pigeon, it's officers and trustees, by reason of any damages to property, personal injury or bodily injury, including death, sustained by any person whomsoever and which damage, injury or death arises.
26. The Applicant further understands that the Pigeon Chamber of Commerce has Pigeon Village Council approved authority and control over the event grounds, as well as designated parking areas during the event.
27. The Applicant further understands that should the location change for the event, all rules and fees remain in effect at the new location.
28. Event Sponsors reserve the right to place food vendors on the festival grounds according to a master plan. Therefore, any cancellations by food vendor based on dissatisfaction of booth placement will subject food vendor to forfeiture of all booth fees.
