Lori K suggested contacting Country Gardens for help and Michelle S suggested using the ISE Exchange Students to help as they are required to commit 5 hours to community service. Terry B made a motion to approve up to \$1,000.00 to the Easter Egg Hunt, seconded by Erica R.

Erica K recommended an idea to include a "Farm to Table" dinner in the streets of Pigeon as part of the Fall Harvest Celebration. The idea being a sit down, catered dinner served to 100 pre-sold ticket holders on the Saturday following. Potential Raffle Tickets, alcohol permit etc. More discussion to continue.

2024 Vacation Guide

Ric Aymen presented the costs for the 2024 Vacation Guide.

In 2023, we paid \$1,895.00 for two full pages and 2 - \$10 web links on thumbnet.net (one for each page)

In 2024, we will pay \$1,925.00 for two full pages and 2 - \$10 web links on thumbnet.net. That's an increase of \$30.00.

This cost is split with the festival committee so the Chamber will pay \$962.50.

Erica R asked what the cost would be if we reduce to 1 page, ½ for the Chamber and ½ page for the festival committee then this cost would be approximately half @ \$962.50 for all and \$481.25 for the Chamber.

Ric A will contact Sheila M from the festival committee for her input. This subject was tabled until the next meeting. The deadline for the decision is the end of March.

Other Business:

If the committee chooses to keep the meetings on the 2nd Wed of the month at noon, we will need to move meetings from the Event Center on May 8th, and July 10th as the venue is already booked.
